






## **Indoor Unit Overview**


The appearance of the actual product may differ slightly from the image below.

- 03 Eco indicator



## Cleaning

#### Auto clean function

Use the Auto clean function if the indoor unit produces odors.

### **Activating Auto clean**

To activate Auto clean, press the Options (Options) button for at least 3 seconds.

### Canceling Auto clean

To cancel Auto clean while it is running, follow the procedure below:





### **Deactivating Auto clean**

To deactivate Auto clean, follow the procedure below while the air conditioner is in operation :












### Cleaning the filter

Clean the air filter every two weeks or when the  $\Gamma$ F (filter-cleaning reminder) appears on the indoor unit display. The time between cleanings may vary, depending on the usage and environmental conditions.



- 1 Slide the filter off of the unit.
- 2 Use a soft brush or vacuum cleaner to remove any dust or debris on the filter.
- **3** Soak the filter in a solution of water and mild detergent for 30 minutes.
- 4 Rinse the filter and let it air dry in a well-ventilated area that is out of direct sunlight.
- **5** Reinstall the filter.
- **6** Reset the filter-cleaning reminder:




